



CHANGES

As noted on the front page of the ServeNebraska Request for Competitive AmeriCorps*State Applications and related materials, the Request for Applications is being issued while the underlying Corporation for National & Community Service materials are in a Public Comment. Revision is possible. Below is a summary of the changes resulting from this public comment period and the impact on the funding process. The Request for Application materials have been revised to reflect the changes below.

Explanation:

Due to many factors and delays in its ability to post complete application information, the Corporation for National & Community Service (CNCS) has made the decision to push the due date of the applications from multi-state applicants and state service commissions back two weeks to January 22, 2014 at 5:00 pm Eastern. To allow sufficient time for the grant application review process, this will also push the notification date for applicants from April 18, 2014 to May 2, 2014. CNCS expects that successful applicants will be notified no later than May 2, 2014, contingent on timely full year appropriations.

Impact:

- The due date for Nebraska entities seeking to participate in the Governor's & Mayor Initiative is moved to January 22, 2014 [Cover page, Page 9, Page 17]
- The due date for multi-state proposals applying directly to the Corporation for National & Community Service is moved to January 22, 2014 [Page 3]
- The anticipated Competitive funding announcement from the Corporation for National & Community Service is moved to May 2, 2014 [Page 6, Page 33]
