AMERICORPS ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

In recognition of the value and impact of the services and experiences of every AmeriCorps alumni to their communities, UI&U is proud to offer the following scholarships:

1. As a full time student in either an undergraduate or graduate program, an AmeriCorps Alumni may apply for one of the following scholarships.
 - Undergraduate: Up to \$3,000 total scholarship to be awarded at \$750 per semester for the student's first 4 semesters at UI&U.
OR
 - Graduate: Up to \$2,000.00 total scholarship to be awarded \$500.00 per semester for the student's first 4 semesters at UI&U.

2. Application fee waived.
3. The transfer of academic credits is subject to the policies stated in the UI&U Catalog. <http://www.myunion.edu/academics/university-catalog.html>.

Requirements to receive the Union Institute & University AmeriCorps Alumni scholarship:

1. Acceptance and enrollment into an undergraduate or graduate program at Union Institute & University.
2. Continuous full-time enrollment is required.
3. Student must maintain satisfactory academic progress.
4. This scholarship may be used in conjunction with employer tuition reimbursement and/or state and federal grants, the combination of which is not to exceed the total cost of tuition, books and fees to the student.
5. Evidence of completion of AmeriCorps service term is required to be eligible for the scholarship.

For **undergraduate** students, AmeriCorps alumni who have completed a full service year are encouraged to have their year of service evaluated for undergraduate college credit. UI&U's generous college credit transfer policies, acceptance of AP, CLEP and DANTES test results and recognition of past training carrying the American College of Education (ACE) credit award often help our adult students move towards undergraduate degree completion at an accelerated pace.
