Proclamation

- WHEREAS,** Youth from across Nebraska are leaders in volunteerism and community service; and
- WHEREAS,** ServeNebraska – the Nebraska Volunteer Service Commission and the University of Nebraska – Omaha, Nebraska's 2009 Global Youth Service Day lead agencies, provide leadership and inspire other organizations to instill a strong sense of service and civic engagement in Nebraska youths on Global Youth Service Day; and
- WHEREAS,** State Farm has provided corporate leadership, funding resources and commitment to local communities across Nebraska to engage youth in service; and
- WHEREAS,** Youth Service America has provided national leadership, resources and a commitment to engaging tomorrow's leaders; and
- WHEREAS,** ServeNebraska and the University of Nebraska – Omaha have strengthened Nebraska's capacity to serve by effectively leveraging resources; and
- WHEREAS,** This year through the efforts of ServeNebraska, the University of Nebraska – Omaha and State Farm, more than 1,000 youth volunteers will devote a day of service to local non-profit organizations, schools and municipalities; and
- WHEREAS,** Non-profit organizations, schools and municipalities in all areas of Nebraska will be impacted by the service of Nebraska's youths in their local communities through service-learning, conservation, disability inclusion, environmental stewardship, public safety and other areas; and
- WHEREAS,** Global Youth Service Day is an opportune time for citizens to salute youth volunteers and their leaders for helping Nebraska preserve the Good Life for generations to come; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Dave Heineman, Governor of the State of Nebraska, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM the days of April 24 - 26, 2009, as

in Nebraska, and I do hereby urge all citizens to thank volunteers of all ages for their service and to find ways to give back to their communities.
