



Edward M. Kennedy Serve America Act

On April 21, 2009 President Barack Obama signed into law the Edward M. Kennedy Serve America Act, cementing a historic piece of bipartisan legislation that will enhance and grow national service in Nebraska and throughout the United States. President Obama called the act the "boldest expansion" of service opportunities since the creation of AmeriCorps under President Bill Clinton.
