



ServeNebraska is not currently accepting applications for AmeriCorps funding

ServeNebraska conducted funding processes for 2011-2012 Competitive and Formula AmeriCorps programming operating exclusively within Nebraska. The deadline for Competitive funding was December 10, 2010. The deadline for Formula funding was April 15, 2011. AmeriCorps funding provides community-based non-profit organizations and public entities resources to address human services, educational, environmental, public safety, and disaster preparedness needs. In order to further the understanding of the funding process, ServeNebraska provides the information below.

- Competitive funds are awarded by the federal Corporation for National & Community Service to entities experienced in successfully implementing significant-scale multi-site national or community service programming with sophisticated, well-developed program designs addressing human services, educational, environmental, public safety, and disaster preparedness needs. For programs operating exclusively within Nebraska, ServeNebraska recommends selected applicants for Competitive funding consideration. Applications submitted for Competitive consideration but not selected by the Corporation for National & Community Service for Competitive funding will be eligible for state Formula funding consideration.
- Formula funds are allocated exclusively at the state level to support outstanding programming. Newer and smaller scale programs tend to be supported with Formula funds. The amount of Formula funds available annually to each state is determined through a population-based formula devised by the Corporation for National & Community Service.
